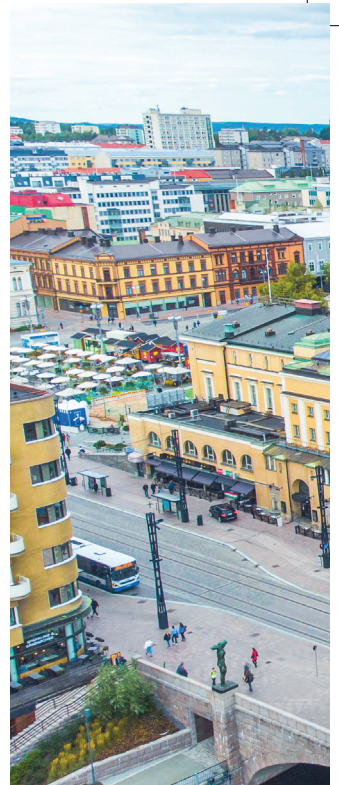

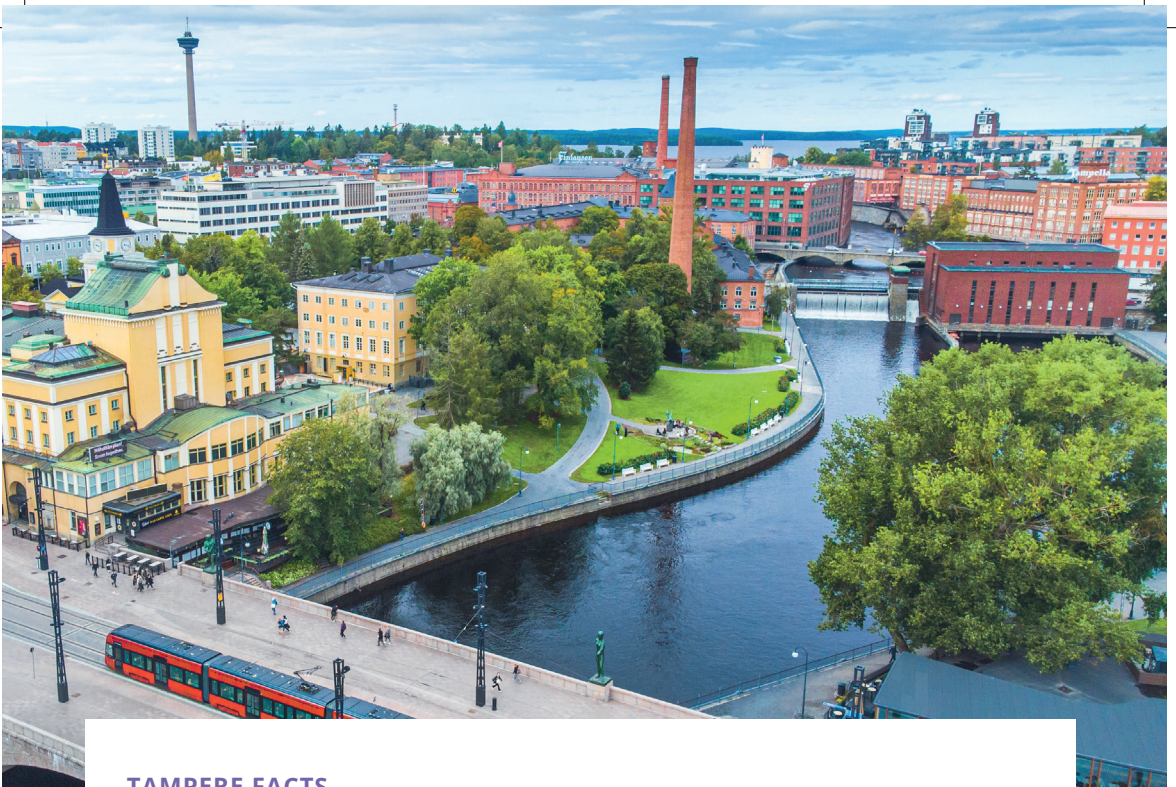
## IML VAASAN MARSSI 2025
