

# **RULES OF ADMISSION**

of the International Federation of Popular Sports (IVV)

by resolution of the Congress of Delegates in Luxembourg

on the 9<sup>th</sup> of July, 2010

## **§ 1 Admission**

- (1) National associations and direct member clubs from countries that do not have a national public sports association may join the IVV.
- (2) Generally, only one public sports association per country will be accepted.

## **§ 2 Admission Procedure**

- (1) An applicant has to forward a written application to the IVV Head Office, Fabrikstrasse 8, Altötting (Germany).
- (2) The application has to include:
  - a) Minutes of the inaugural meeting of the applying association or direct member club
  - b) Statutes of association or club in the version valid at date of application.
  - c) Recent legal proof of a national authority on the approval of the association or club.
  - d) A recent listing of the executive committee members of association or club.
  - e) A listing of clubs of the association with location and address of the responsible representative.
  - f) A written declaration of the association or club to acknowledge and comply with the statutes, orders and guidelines of the IVV.
  - g) A detailed report on the structures and activities of the applying association or club.

## **§ 3 Responsibility**

- (1) The IVV Presidium decides on acceptance of a direct member club after checking the documents according to § 2 of the Rules of Admission.
- (2) The Congress of Delegates will decide on acceptance of a new member association.

The IVV Presidium will check the documentation presented for completeness, and is entitled to ask for missing or additional documents from the applicant giving a written deadline.

The IVV Presidium will write a report on the preliminary check which has to be presented to the member countries at least 3 months prior to the Congress of Delegates on the IVV website (internal area). The report has to comment on the application in detail, especially if all necessary documents have been submitted.
